ABSTRACT

The internship training was conducted at Ogolai Sub County in Amuria District local government for a period of Eight weeks from 28th february, 2022 to 27th April, 2022. The purpose of this training was to equip students with sustainable practical skills that are relevant to their respective courses especially in (APM) Animal Production and Management. During this period of Eight weeks, many activities were under taken shortly and these included deworming, field visit, disease surveillance, conducting demonstration, treating sick animals, vaccination of bovine against FMD advisory services, farmer training and disease diagnosis and treatment. Never the less, many challenges were encountered during the internship period such as bad weather condition, tiresome work done and inadequate transport to the field.
