1.1 Organization Background.

SORUDA is a national non- governmental organization (NGO), it was registered in 2000 under ministry of internal affair of the republic of Uganda. Its authorized to operate in Uganda .its head office is based in Soroti district in their own block on plot No.45 old Mbale it road.

SORUDA Kitgum Lamwo office started in June 2017 with funding from OXFAM under the project of ELNHA and the project was for six month. DGD started in Oct2017-Sep 2018 and ELNHA kicked on from May – Oct 2018 which supports livelihood projects. This project mainly supports refugees in palabek resettlement and part of the host communities.

SORUDA Soroti supported livelihood project. Soroti district from December 2011- November 2014, which was engaged, mobilizing communities into enterprises, based on production strengthening and diversifying livelihood holds production and advocating for food rights of poor rural households. The project was funded by war on want northern Ireland (WOWNI)

HIV/AIDS, Gender Based Violence (GBV) and good governance project in June 2011- may 2013 that aims at empowering rural communities to reduce on human right s abuse, holding duty bearers accountable to the duty holders. This was being done with grants from Independent Development Fund (IDF)-Kampala.

Support utilization of p4p community satellite stores in Teso Sub-region in (August 2012-2013) this action aims to increase the locally purchased food volume sand utilization of existing p4p community stores by the small holder- farmers and medium scale traders in Teso sub-region .

This was achieved through building capacity in phh, farming as a business, store management and provision of timely market information under Agriculture and Market Support Project (AMS) funded by UN-WFP.
