Sebei Elgon Co-operative Union under the Nile breweries is one of the farms in Kapchorwa District. The working station is located at the Nucleus farm and it is ten kilometres from Bukwo town and seven miles from Suam boarder, and the mailing address is Sebei Elgon Co-operative Union, P.o box, 12 Kapchorwa

It started in 1980 being owned by a white man called Mr. Cipi Gellins who sold it to Sebei Elgon Co-operative Union (Nile breweries) and the first farm manager Mr. Asanasiyo Wusha.

The farm has 1760acres and it is privately owned by the farmers who are engaged in planting crops like barley, wheat, maize and rear some domestic animals like cattle and the farm's organisation is co-operatively formed by the farmers of the area

The farmers after harvesting offer their produce to Uganda grain milling company in Jinja for producing.
